Bottlenecks CER benefits for Africa

- Difficult, because widespread consumers and less organised environment
- Decrease monitoring cost of projects
- Political risk longer term (>3 yrs)
- Lacking data / baseline
- Low industrial activity / 'clean' baseline
- Policy / research / training infrastructure
